**Subject Federation of German-American Clubs (FGAC/VDAC) Scholarship**

We will be awarding two Federation of German-American Clubs Scholarships for study at a German university during the coming academic year. These scholarships are funded by the Federation of German-American Clubs in cooperation with the Department of German Studies at the University of Arizona.

(Each provides approximately 4,500 Euro for ten months.)

### **To qualify, you must meet the following criteria:**

- 1) have taken at least two years of college German or equivalent by the date of departure
- 2) at least Junior standing at time of departure – Fall 2017
- 3) at least a “B” average in all college courses taken, and “B+” in all college German courses
- 4) still be an undergraduate during the year abroad
- 5) be a U.S. citizen
- 6) not be married (a requirement of the German government)

### **To apply:**

- Pick up an application form in the main office of the Department of German Studies (Learning Services Building, Third Floor).
- Please submit your application with all supporting materials to Holly Lysne (Learning Services Building, German Studies Department) by December 1.
- Up to two scholarships will be awarded by February 1, after applications have been reviewed and personal interviews with applicants have been conducted by the screening committee.
